## **SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

The Trojan Volleyball team earned their **second consecutive state championship** by defeating EGR in the semis and Tecumseh in the finals. They also continued their winning ways, taking home Conference and GMAA championships.

The Wrestling team won the first District since 2003 and advanced to the regional finals.

Long time football coach and mentor **Steve Wilson** (148-79) retired after 23 years at the Trojan helm.

The renovated “old gym”, also known as the “Barn” became an instant hit for hosting volleyball matches.

Some long standing track and field records were broken this year: The boys relay team of **Chris Eaton, David VanBergen, Nico Cerniglia, and Cody Pikel** broke the 1985 record in the 1600 m relay with a time of 3:30.45. Records broken in girls track were **Brianna Pikel** in the 400 M (58.08), and the 4 x 100 relay team of **Kayleigh Schulte, Brianna Pikel, Hanna Klinger, and Heidi Klinger**, who broke a record that lasted 33 years by .3 seconds (50.91).

Other school records were set this year, including **Kaylee McWilliams** (girls golf “best 9” score of 43); **Logan Stong** (boys soccer for .86 goals against goalkeeper average); **Cody Bayle** (16 strikeouts in a game and 96 for the season);

The Fruitport Football field was awarded one of the Pioneer Athletics *Fields of Excellence* for 2011 for the care, support, and overall superior maintenance in the nationwide judging. Congrats to **John Winkas** and staff!

Fruitport hosted MHSAA District events in Girls Basketball and Girls Soccer, and conference events in tennis.

The **Girls Basketball team** not only had the best record in school history, but also ranked fourth in the state for team GPA (3.82).

Participation rates have increased for both male and female athletes at FHS. The percentage of the student body participating in athletics is up 3% from 2010-11, and 4% from 2006-07.

Several teams participated in voluntary service projects this past year. The football team continued their elementary reading program, the construction of wheelchair ramps, and assisting the Lions Club with Old Fashioned Days activities. The Boys and Girls Basketball teams, Boys Soccer teams, and the Varsity Softball team joined forces with **No More Sidelines** and ran activities and clinics for special needs athletes. The Girls Basketball teams raised funds and awareness in the fight against cancer by contributing to the travel expenses for Mariah Ackerman and her family. The Girls Soccer team contributed to the special fundraiser for Hudsonville High School, who was raising funds to help research a rare disease that has disabled the two young sons of their opponents’ coach.

The average g.p.a. for all senior athletes was 3.24, compared to the senior average of 3.0.

The Fruitport Athletic Foundation awarded **\$10, 913** in coach grants for athletic teams from grades 7-12.

**Lauren Hazekamp** was voted the best female athlete in the Muskegon Chronicle area and was Fruitport’s third female athlete to be inducted into the Muskegon Area Hall of Fame.

A **record 21 student athletes** were awarded the Fruitport Athletic Foundation’s Outstanding Achievement Award for earning 6 or more career varsity letters.

Coach **Bob Dorman** reached 100 wins this year as both JV Boys Basketball Coach and Varsity Softball Coach.
