### SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

One of the most exciting football games of the season was the overtime win over Muskegon Catholic Central. The game drew extra attention as the two schools have not met on the gridiron since 1976.

Fruitport hosted MHSAA District Baseball and Softball, Wrestling Regionals, and GMAA Competitive Cheer.

JV Boys Basketball player **Nathan Kriger** scored 50 points in a double overtime loss at Tri County.

The Trojans qualified 4 wrestlers for the state championships this season. Also, **Tommy Martinez** and **Collin Butler** reached the 100 wins milestone.

Fruitport honored two teams and 8 individuals into its first **Athletics Hall of Fame**. Over 260 people attended the March Induction Banquet sponsored by the Fruitport Athletic Foundation.

**Nine senior student athletes** were awarded the Fruitport Athletic Foundation's Outstanding Achievement Award for earning six or more career varsity letters.

Three new coaches began their Varsity coaching careers this year.

**A new school record** in Boys Track is now in the books. **Noah Hendricks, Cody Pekel, Zack Gilson, and Shawn Knox** broke the one year old record by recording a 3:30.19 time in the 4 x 400 m relay.

The Fruitport Athletic Foundation awarded **\$10,435** in coach grants for athletic teams from grades 7-12.
